

Report on International Workshop on 'Research Methodology in Social Sciences'

The Departments of Business Economics and Commerce (Aided & Self-Finance Courses) jointly with Internal Quality Assurance Cell of S.I.W.S N.R. Swamy College of Commerce & Economics and Smt. Thirumalai College of Science in collaboration with International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS) organized an International workshop on Research Methodology in Social Sciences from 5-9 October, 2021.

116 participants participated in the workshop. The participants who registered for the program included post graduate students, research scholars and faculties from different parts of the country. **Dr. Ravi Verma**, Director of International Centre for Research on Women (ICRW) Asia Chapter, New Delhi was the Chief Guest and **Dr K.S James**, **Director**, IIPS was the Guest of Honour for the inaugural function. Principal Dr Usha Iyer addressed the participants and encouraged them with her motivating words. She explained the relevance of quantitative and qualitative research in social sciences, giving an overview of the topics selected for the workshop. Dr Ravi Verma graced the occasion with his keynote address on the significance of research and its implications on social sciences. He congratulated Dr Usha Iyer for conceptualizing the idea of holding a workshop on this important topic and highlighted the scope of research and its applications in day to day life. Dr James spoke about issues and concepts related to the research process and encouraged the delegates to undertake quality research.

Dr Dhananjay Bansod, Professor, Department of Public Health and Mortality Studies, International Institute of Population Sciences conducted the first day session on 'Significance of Research and Quantitative Research Methods for Social Sciences'. He spoke about meaning, importance, purpose and relevance of research in various fields. He highlighted the significance of research for government for policy making, surveys, demographers, educational institutions and students, different steps involved in research viz. conceptual phase, empirical phase and analytical phase. Further he spoke about types, methods of quantitative data measurement, collection of data through traditional and new methods like survey, interviews and questionnaire. He concluded the session with various strategies for designing questions for data collection, characteristics of a good questionnaire, the list of do's and don'ts of interview for data collection and pretesting of collected quantitative data. Dr Bansod encouraged the participants to ask questions and answered all their questions.

On the second day, the session on 'Qualitative Research Methods for Social Sciences-Referencing and Citation in Research' was engaged by **Dr. Harihar Sahoo**, Associate Professor, Dept. of Development Studies, IIPS, Mumbai. Dr Sahoo spoke about sampling in qualitative research, concepts of social mapping and pile sorting, stages of participant observation, technique of conducting interviews, content analysis and meta analysis and importance of group discussion and transcription. Participants took keen interest and raised several questions related to qualitative research.

On the third day, Dr. Venkata Putcha, Director/Consultant, Sriv UK Ltd., Harrow, London, United Kingdom conducted a session on 'How to publish research findings (peer reviewed journal) in Social Sciences'. He clarified important aspects related to impact factor, types of manuscripts, selection of best journals for publications, general structure of full articles and importance of working backwards in publications and thesis.

He further expressed his views on scientific language senses in developing a research title and scientific language in social science research.

On Day 4, the session on 'Ethics and Integrity aspects of Social Science Research' was conducted by **Dr. Srinivasa Rao**, Professor, Sociology of Education, Zakir Hussain Centre for Educational Studies, School of Social Sciences, Jawaharlal Nehru University. Dr Rao discussed sampling, its importance, academic integrity in research and prevention of plagiarism. He further discussed the stages in research and sampling decisions, truthfulness in research, identifying the problem and hypothesis. He also explained pre-requisites of a good questionnaire.

On the last day, **Dr Manas Ranjan Pradhan**, Assistant Professor, Department of Fertility Studies, IIPS spoke on 'Research Proposal and Research Report Writing'. He emphasised on the writing skills required for a research proposal along with key ideas on how to frame appropriate research objectives. He explained in details the steps involved in drafting a research report and guided the participants in understanding the integrity of writing research proposals for academic purpose. Further, he explained the various components of research proposal that included introduction, methods and materials, analysis and planning, references and time schedule. He also threw light on different components involved in writing a research report and highlighted that the main purpose of research proposal is to convince the reader about the project values.





Report on 'Webinar titled Values: A Compass for Navigating Uncertain Times'

Academic Year-2020-2021

Introduction: The Universal Human Values Cell, University of Mumbai in collaboration with the IQAC and the Department of Business Communication of SIWS College conducted a Webinar- 'Values: A Compass for Navigating Uncertain Times' on 27 November, 2021 using the Digital Video Conferencing platform "Zoom". The event began with a welcome address by Dr Kirti Y. Nakhare, Dept of Business Communication, SIWS College and UHV Cell member. Greetings and pleasantries were exchanged between the resource people and SIWS College staff members. Dr. Usha S. Iyer, Principal, SIWS College, and Dr Sybil Thomas, Co Ordinator, UHV Cell, University of Mumbai addressed the audience on the importance of values and the role played by values in our day-to-day lives.

Objectives of the webinar: To introduce values to students and to stress on the importance of values

Outcome of webinar: Students were able to connect with the speakers and realised the importance of values and its application in everyday situations.51 students attended the webinar.

Resource People: The webinar comprised five speakers, whose sessions touched upon various aspects pertaining to values. The first speaker Dr Smita Shukla's In-charge director of Alkesh Dinesh Mody Institute for Financial and Management Studies aptly titled her session 'Role of Human Values in Commerce and Business' Dr Shukla touched upon business ethics and aligned areas related to commerce and management.

Report on National Workshop on Electron Microscopy of Nanoparticles-

Department of Physics and Chemistry conducted a National Workshop on *Electron Microscopy of Nanoparticles*, in association with National centre for Nanosciences and Nanotechnology, University of Mumbai, on September 23, 2017. The schedule of workshop was divided into two sessions - the first session of the workshop was held in the seminar room of our college and the second session was held at National Centre for Nanosciences and Nanotechnology, University of Mumbai, Kalina Campus.

Objectives:

- To provide a platform for future exchange of ideas and research in Nanoparticles
- To provide in-depth theoretical and practical knowledge to faculty and students working on different facets of nanoparticle characterisation using electron microscopy.
- To provide the latest updates about the materials research and the advancements achieved in the upcoming and novel areas

The first session of the workshop consisted of three lectures by three eminent scientists of international fame.

> Prof. Pushan Ayyub, Senior Professor and Chair of the Department of Condensed Matter Physics and Material Science, Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, Homi Bhabha Road, Mumbai - 400 005, was the Chief Guest of the Workshop, as well as the speaker of the first session.

The topic of his talk for the workshop was - Looking at Nanostructures by High Resolution Electron Microscopy: Pros and Cons

During his hour long talk, Prof. Ayyub discussed in detail the technical aspects of *High Resolution Electron Microscopy*. He explained about the technique, for the study of structure and composition at the scale of nanometers (0.1-10nm), i.e., in nanostructured materials. While the diameter of a Hydrogen atom is 0.1 nm and a Lithium atom is 0.3 nm, the best modern TEMs can "see" down to 0.07 nm! The 1-Angstrom (=0.1nm) barrier was broken over 10 years back with the invention of the aberration corrected TEM. But many of us still use a TEM only to find the particle size of nanoparticles which are 5-50nm in size! While

electron microscopy gives us crucial information about the shape and size distribution, Sir will told us about several critical – and frequently unrecognized – pitfalls that we often face when we use TEM for the routine determination of mean particle size in nanostructured systems. Electron microscopy is irreplaceable for the study of nanomaterials.

Dr. Deepa Khushalani, Associate Professor in Materials Chemistry, Dept. of Chemical Sciences, Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, Homi Bhabha Road, Mumbai - 400 005, was the speaker of the second session.

Dr. Khushalani has many recognitions and award to her credit-

Her research areas are: Synthesis, characterization and application of a variety of inorganic structures such that (1) the morphology, phase, and size are carefully manipulated so that there is precise control over homogeneity and compositional purity, (2) the ensuing materials are applied in areas such as heterogeneous photocatalysis, biosensors, components in solar cells and in energy storage devices (such as batteries and supercapacitors) and also for drug delivery applications. Her other activities: Extensively involved in Science Outreach and actively promoted basic sciences within rural and economically deprived areas of India. Given several workshops/lectures and mentoring sessions.

The topic of her talk for the workshop was - Electron Microscopy: An Invaluable Tool in Study of Functional Materials





National Symposium on Demonetization: Rationale, Costs & Benefits and Future for India Organized by

The Department of Business Economics

SIWS NR Swamy College of Commerce & Economics, Wadala, Mumbai organized a National Symposium on 'Demonetization: Rationale, Costs & Benefits and Future for India' in collaboration with Alkesh Dinesh Mody Institute for Financial and Management Studies, University of Mumbai on April 26, 2017.

The symposium had invited distinguished speakers comprising of academicians, independent economists and experts from the corporate world and authorities of the Reserve Bank of India to present their views on the much debated topic.

The Symposium had three Panel Sessions:

Session I - Rationale Behind Demonetization;

Session II - Demonetization: Costs and Benefits:

Session III - Demonetization: Future of India

A souvenir on the title was released comprising of Research papers and abstracts. The convenor of the Conference **Dr. Aarti Prasad** said that never before in Independent India has the RBI faced a bigger challenge than having to replace 86 percent of the currency at such an incredibly short notice.

Speaking at the Inaugural Function, the Chief Guest **Dr. Ajit Ranade**, Senior President and Chief Economist, Aditya Birla Group pointed out that the Demonetization move was beyond economics; it was a political move, with the desire to showcase it to the world. What stood out was the peaceful acceptance by the people, he pointed out, unlike the Venezuelan experience, where people took to the streets forcing the government to do a U turn. The decline in GDP was only marginal during that quarter and not as much as was made out to be by the critics. He also added that the election results in UP, the largest State of the country, where the BJP won by a thumping victory did not indicate the discontent of the people.

He congratulated the Principal, faculty and SIWS Management for having organized an event on a current and relevant topic within five months of its implementation. A souvenir was released with abstracts of research papers.



The Guest of Honour at the Inaugural function **Dr. K. Srikant**, Director, Ramanuja Mission Trust, Coimbatore highlighted the resilience and the law abiding nature of the Indian people as an inherent part of Indian culture.

Dr. Barendra Bhoi, ex-President, Monetary Management, Unit of RBI said that demonetization step should not be seen in isolation as the government was trying to attack corruption in a systematic way. He equated it to chemotherapy, which had to be resorted to when conservative treatment was not successful.

Other Key Speakers in the panel were **Dr. Brinda Jagirdar**, Retd. General Manager and Chief Economist of State Bank of India, Shri. **Parthasarathy**, Manager, Consumer Education and Protection Cell, Reserve Bank of India, **Dr. Vibhuti Patel**, Head, PG Department of Economics SNDT Women's University, **Dr. Smita Shukla** IC Director ADM Institute of Financial and Management Studies, University of Mumbai and Dr. Usha Sukumar Iyer Principal, SIWS College, Wadala.

More than twenty research papers were received and paper presentations were made by Delegates who were from academics and Industry and also students from diversified fields.

The Chief Guest at the Valedictory function **Shri R. Gandhi**, Ex. Deputy Governor, Reserve Bank of India said that Demonetization was a bold move by the Government targeting terror funding across the border by a counterfeit currency, tracking benami transactions, attack dubious companies which avoid taxes, stopping malpractices in election and promoting usage of banking and digital transactions. The logistics was planned well in advance and executed well and it received public support.

The Chairperson of the Conference, Principal **Dr. Usha Iyer** who proposed the theme of the Conference said that any slowdown due to demonetization would only be short-lived. Once the systems get adjusted to the new normal, its benefits will be reaped in the long run. She reiterated that Demonetization is a giant step towards the dream of making a digital India.


