






## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- While entering the college a learner should check his/her dress code. Students are expected to come to the college neat and decently dressed.
- The college campus must be kept neat and clean. All waste materials must be thrown in the dustbin.
- Student must not loiter in the College corridors or play in the gymkhana when the lectures, tutorials, practicals, tests and examinations are in progress.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited in the College Premises and Canteen.
- Identity Cards and latest fee receipt must be produced whenever the students appear for any tests or examinations in the college.
- Use of mobile phones in the classroom/tutorial sessions and seminar hall is strictly prohibited. A penalty will be charged from students who continue to use mobile phones at these places inspite of repeated warnings.
- Collection of money in the premises of the College for any activity without written permission of the Principal is prohibited.
- If any student is found carrying or possessing knife, arms, crackers or explosives in the premises of the College, he/she will be instantly expelled from the College and his/her admission stands cancelled.
- No student will be allowed to indulge in any political activity or in any other activity detrimental to the interest of the College.
- Students should take proper care of the College property. Any damage done to the property of the college will have to be compensated either individually or collectively. Resting of feet on the wall and spitting are strictly prohibited.
- Silence must be observed in the library.
- Sitting on cars or vehicles parked in the car premises is prohibited.
- Students who want to take part in any inter-collegiate event should take prior permission of the Principal.
- Students should not do anything either inside or outside the College that will anyway interfere with the orderly conduct and discipline.
- Any misbehaviour/indecent behaviour in the College premises will call for strict disciplinary action. Students are prohibited from bringing any outsider to the College campus without prior permission.



- The Principal reserves the right to discontinue the admission of the student whose acts are detrimental to the best interest of the College.
- Students are required to note that they are not permitted to organize class/group picnics, socials outings without the consent of the Principal or Vice-Principals.
- Students who are found to be disfiguring the classroom and building walls and indulging in vandalism will be fined heavily.
- The Principal's decision will be final regarding admissions.
- In all matters relating to admission, attendance, discipline, conduct and facilities for co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, issue of all forms and certificates, etc. the decision of the Principal shall be final and binding on all the students.

## CODE OF PROFESSIONAL ETHICS FOR TEACHERS

(Source UGC)

### I. Teachers and their Responsibilities:


Whoever adopts teaching as a profession assumes the obligation to conduct himself / herself in accordance with the ideal of the profession. A teacher is constantly under the scrutiny of his students and the society at large. Therefore, every teacher should see that there is no incompatibility between his precepts and practice.

The national ideals of education which have already been set forth and which he/she should seek to inculcate among students must be his/her own ideals. The profession further requires that the teacher should be calm, patient and communicative by temperament and amiable in disposition.

#### Teacher should:

- (i) Adhere to a responsible pattern of conduct and demeanor expected of them by the community;
- (ii) Manage their private affairs in a manner consistent with the dignity of the profession;
- (iii) Seek to make professional growth continuous through study and research;
- (iv) Express free and frank opinion by participation at professional meetings, seminars, conferences etc., towards the contribution of knowledge;
- (v) Maintain active membership of professional organisations and strive to improve education and profession through them;
- (vi) Perform their duties in the form of teaching, tutorials, practicals, seminars and research work, conscientiously and with dedication;
- (vii) Discourage and not indulge in plagiarism and other non-ethical behaviour in teaching and research;

- (viii) Abide by the Act, Statute and Ordinance of the University and to respect its ideals, vision, mission, cultural practices and tradition;
- (ix) Co-operate and assist in carrying out the functions relating to the educational responsibilities of the college and the university, such as: assisting in appraising applications for admission, advising and counselling students as well as assisting the conduct of university and college examinations, including supervision, invigilation and evaluation; and
- (x) Participate in extension, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, including the community service.

## II. Teachers and Students:


### Teachers should:

- (i) Respect the rights and dignity of the student in expressing his/her opinion;
- (ii) Deal justly and impartially with students regardless of their religion, caste, gender, political, economic, social and physical characteristics;
- (iii) Recognise the difference in aptitude and capabilities among students and strive to meet their individual needs;
- (iv) Encourage students to improve their attainments, develop their personalities and at the same time contribute to community welfare;
- (v) Inculcate among students scientific temper, spirit of inquiry and ideals of democracy, patriotism, social justice, environmental protection and peace;
- (vi) Treat the students with dignity and not behave in a vindictive manner towards any of them for any reason;
- (vii) Pay attention to only the attainment of the student in the assessment of merit;
- (viii) Make themselves available to the students even beyond their class hours and help and guide students without any remuneration or reward;
- (ix) Aid students to develop an understanding of our national heritage and national goals;
- (x) Refrain from inciting students against other students, colleagues or administration.

## III. Teachers and Colleagues

- (i) Treat other members of the profession in the same manner as they themselves wish to be treated;
- (ii) Speak respectfully of other teachers and render assistance for professional betterment;
- (iii) Refrain from making unsubstantiated allegations against colleagues to higher authorities;
- (iv) Refrain from allowing considerations of caste, creed, religion, race or sex in their professional endeavour.

#### **IV. Teachers and Authorities :**

##### **Teachers should:**

- (i) Discharge their professional responsibilities according to the existing rules and adhere to procedures and methods consistent with their profession in initiating steps through their own institutional bodies and / or professional organisations for change of any such rule detrimental to the professional interest;
- (ii) Refrain from undertaking any other employment and commitment, including private tuitions and coaching classes which are likely to interfere with their professional responsibilities;
- (iii) Co-operate in the formulation of policies of the institution by accepting various offices and discharge responsibilities which such offices may demand;
- (iv) Co-operate through their organisations in the formulation of policies of the other institutions and accept offices;
- (v) Co-operate with the authorities for the betterment of the institutions keeping in view the interest and in conformity with the dignity of the profession;
- (vi) Adhere to the terms of contract;
- (vii) Give and expect due notice before a change of position takes place;
- (viii) Refrain from availing themselves of leave except on unavoidable grounds and as far as practicable with prior intimation, keeping in view their particular responsibility for completion of academic schedule.

## **V. Teachers and Non-Teaching Staff :**

### **Teachers should :**

- (i) Treat the non-teaching staff as colleagues and equal partners in a cooperative undertaking, within every educational institution;
- (ii) Help in the functioning of joint-staff councils covering both the teachers and the non-teaching staff.

## **VI. Teachers and Guardians :**

### **Teachers should:**

- (i) Try to see through teachers' bodies and organisations, that institutions maintain contact with the guardians, their students, send reports of their performance to the guardians whenever necessary and meet the guardians in meetings convened for the purpose for mutual exchange of ideas and for the benefit of the institution.

## **VII. Teachers and Society :**

### **Teachers should:**

- (i) Recognise that education is a public service and strive to keep the public informed of the educational programmes which are being provided;
- (ii) Work to improve education in the community and strengthen the community's moral and intellectual life;
- (iii) Be aware of social problems and take part in such activities as would be conducive to the progress of society and hence the country as a whole;
- (iv) Perform the duties of citizenship, participate in community activities and shoulder responsibilities of public offices;
- (v) Refrain from taking part in or subscribing to or assisting in any way activities, which tend to promote feeling of hatred or enmity among different communities, religions or linguistic groups but actively work for national integration.
