The students were taken to the nearest mangroves site in Bandra and Sewri for a nature trail and awareness campaign. The forest range officers discussed the importance of mangroves with the students. Students made an effort to clean the forest and expressed their concern in forest protection. The activity was covered in the Marathi daily Lokmat on 18th and 26th February 2018. The students were given certificates from Forest Department, State Government of Maharashtra.

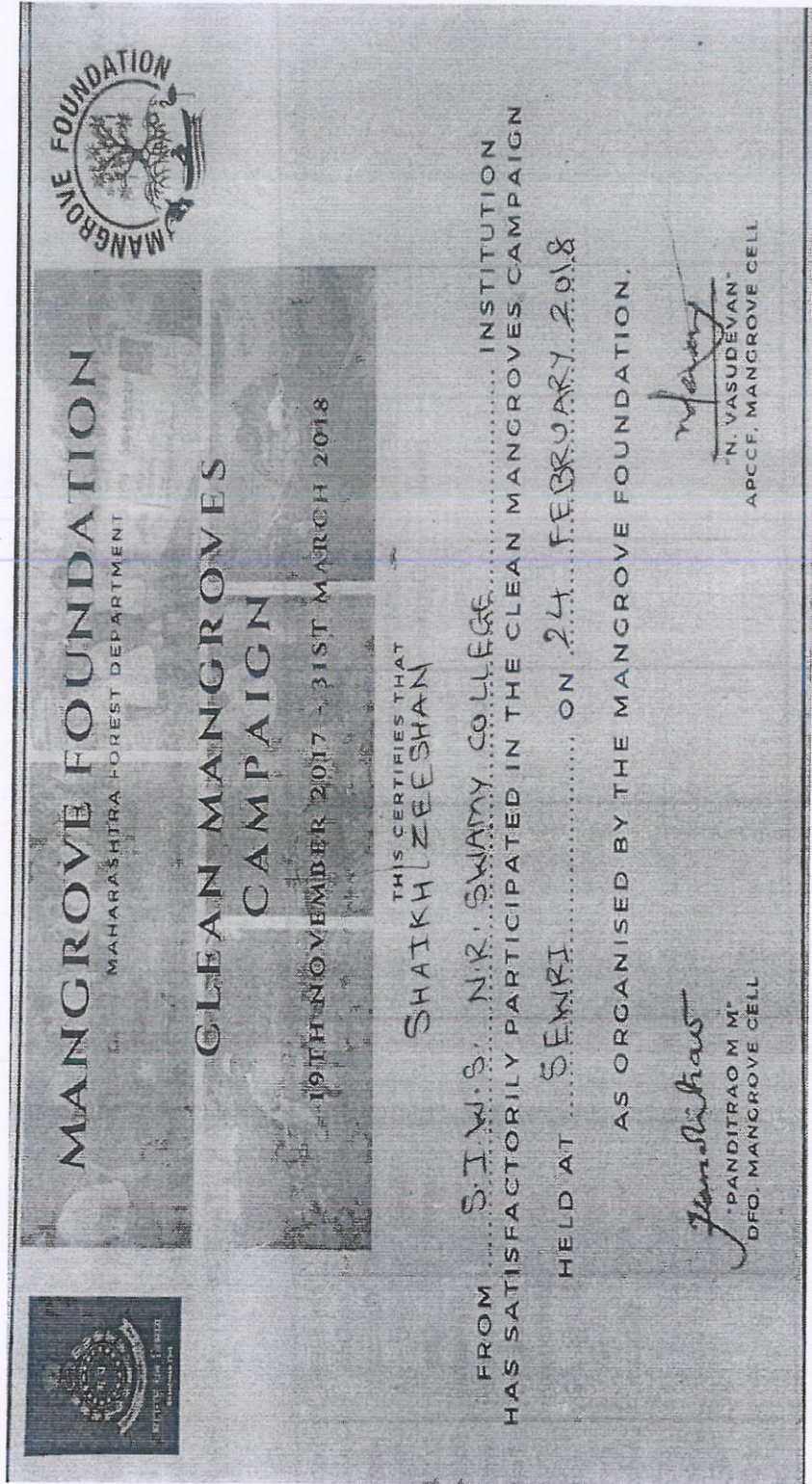



Under Article 48A of the Directive Principles of State Policy, The State shall endeavor to protect and improve the environment and safeguard the forests and wild life of the country. In addition, under 51A(g) of the Fundamental Duties of India it shall be the duty of every citizen to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers and wild life, and to have compassion for living creatures.
