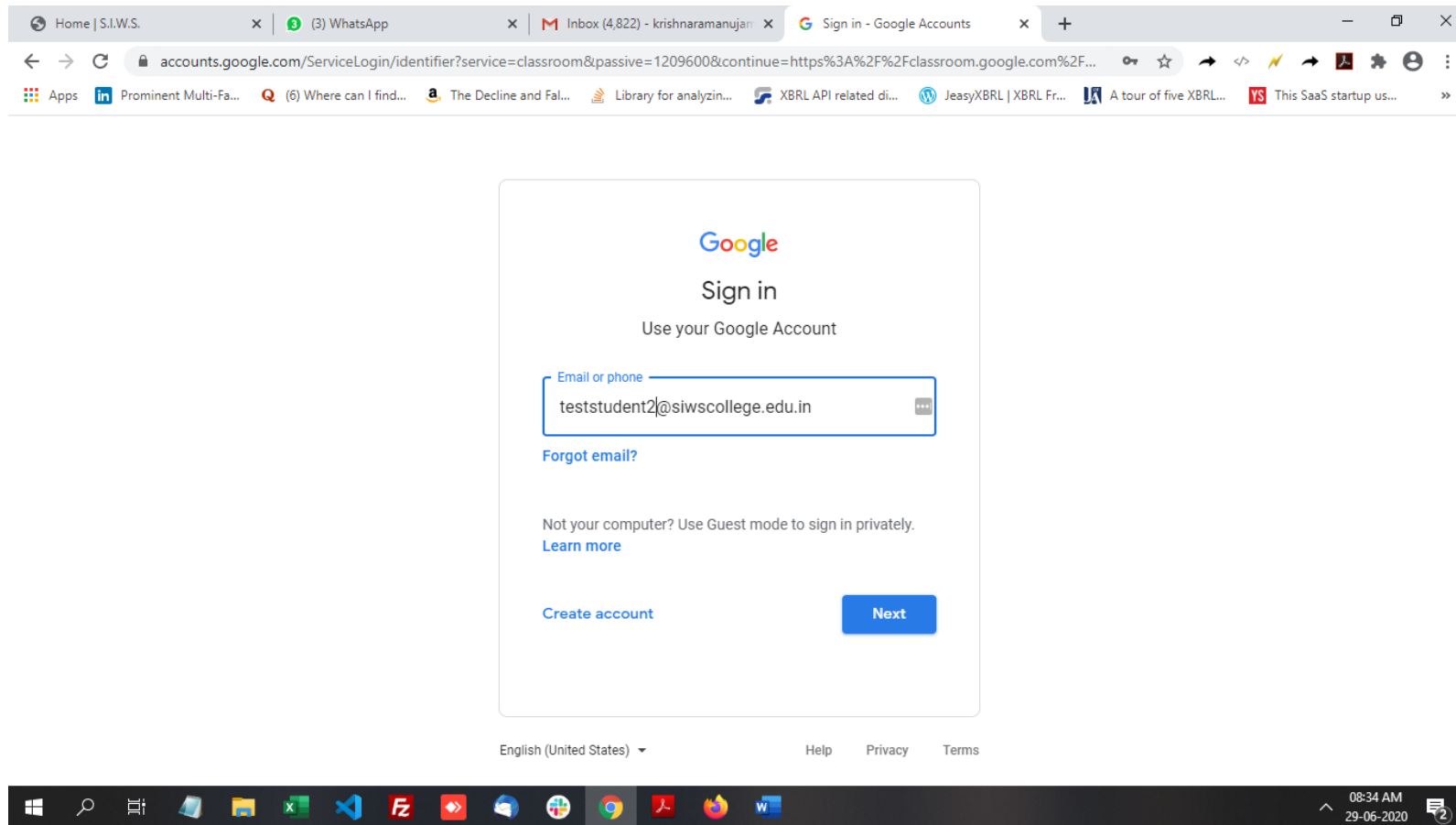


Manual for Signing in to Google Classroom

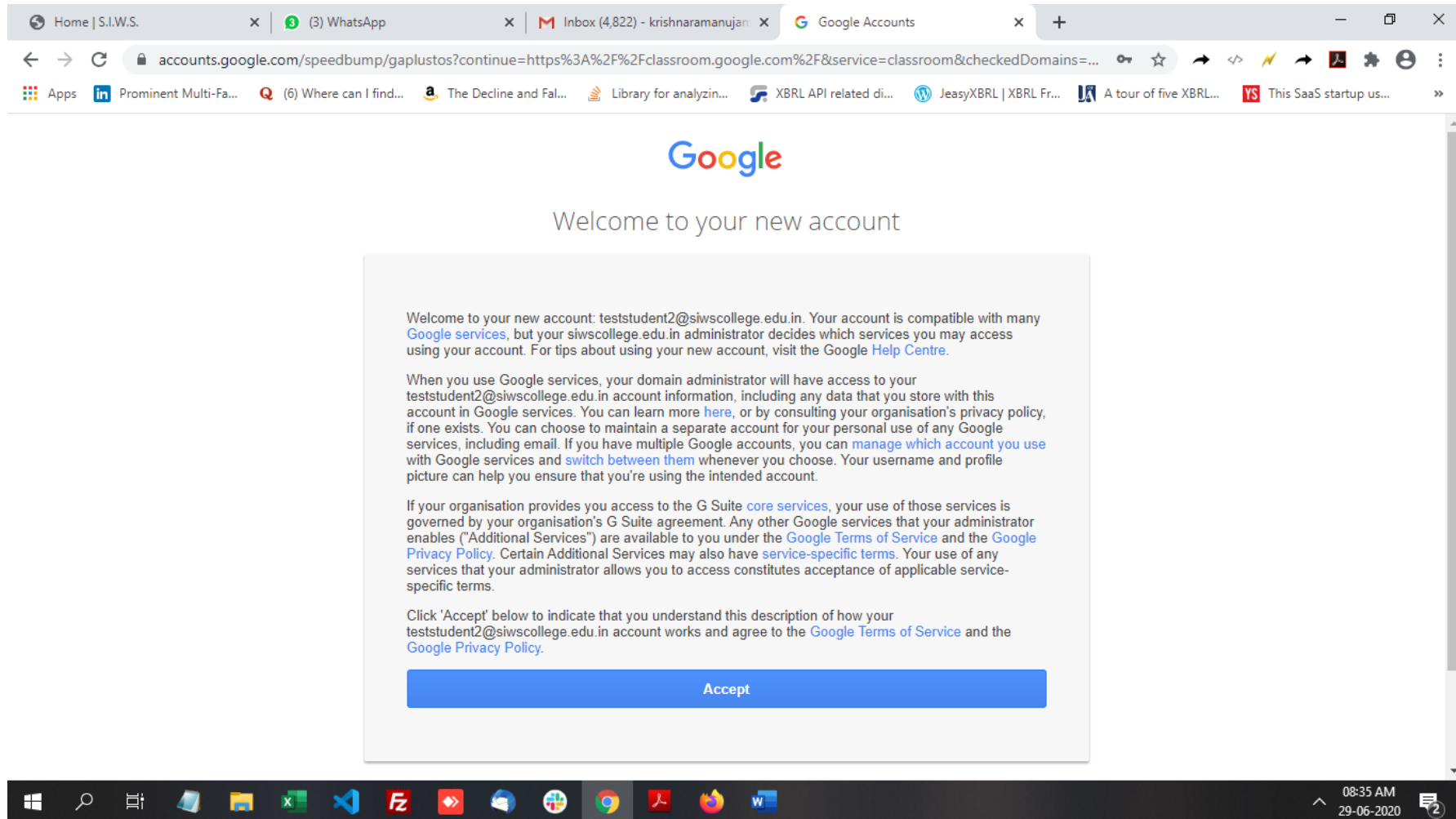


Once the password has been accepted, select ACCEPT on the following screen

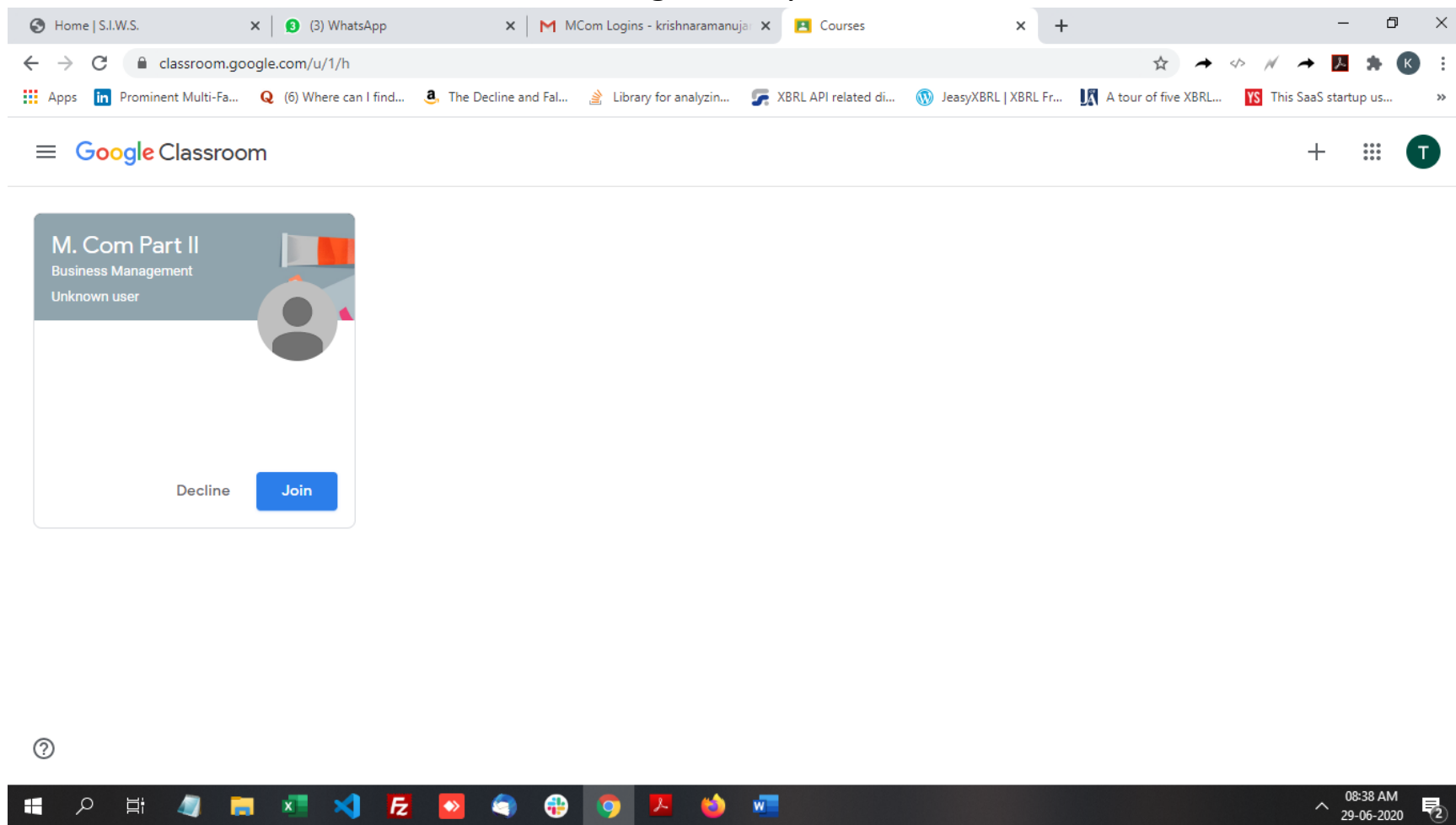
