# DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ECONOMICS

Annual Report: 2018-19

## I. Activities of the Department:

- 1. A Local Inquiry Committee visited SIWS N R Swamy College of Commerce and Economics, Mumbai on June 28, 2018 in pursuance of the application for extension of recognition of the Research Centre for Ph.D. (Commerce) in the subject Business Economics. The College obtained continuation of recognition for its Research Centre to enrol students for Ph.D. (in Commerce & Management) degree Course in the subject of Business Economics for five years from the academic year 2018-19 vide University letter No. Th/ICD/2018-19/3464 dated November 1, 2018.
- **2.** The Department organized a **One-day Revised Syllabus Workshop for T.Y.B.Com** in collaboration with the Board of Studies in Business Economics, **University of Mumbai** on July 20, 2018.
- **3.** In the **Quiz Competition** on **Macro-economic Aspects of India** for **T.Y.B.Com** students of the college in October, 2018, following were the prize winners:

- **4.** A talk on 'Crypto currency' and 'Why IT companies are hiring Economists' by Indradeep Ghosh, Associate Professor and Dean from Meghnad Desai Academy of Economics, Mumbai was organized on Tuesday February 12, 2019.
- 5. Workshop: The Counseling Cell and the Department of Business Economics jointly conducted Counseling Workshop under Skill Sathi Scheme on 13-14 February 2019.

The workshop was conducted by Counseling Implementing Organization (CIO) National Yuva Cooperative Society Limited (NYCS) under the aegis of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MoSDE). The objective of the workshop was to expose students to skill ecosystem and provide alternative career pathways based on aspirations and profiles. The workshop conducted psychometric assessment and registration of students and provided them with details of nearest training centres to enhance professional skills. There was active participation by the students with 969 students successfully registering with the CIO across the two-day workshop.
