Sr. No.	Course Objectives	Course Outcomes
1)	To enable students to get acquainted with and discuss various definitions and concepts of Company Law.	Students would recall various definitions of Company Law and would be acquainted with the concepts of Foreign company, One-person company, etc.
2)	To enable students to get acquainted with and restate the provisions related to Incorporation of Companies.	Students would be aware of various procedures involved in bringing a company into existence and the scope and importance of documents like Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association.
3)	To enable students to discuss and describe the concept of Public Offer.	Students would recall and discuss the process of raising funds for a company by inviting the public to contribute to the same.
4)	To enable students to examine and explain the concept of Private Placement.	Students would discuss the meaning and features of private placement and would examine the circumstances in which companies could raise capital only through known sources.
5)	To introduce students to the concept of Shares and Debentures and enable them to discuss and examine its features.	Students would be acquainted with various types of shares and debentures issued by companies and their features.
