MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

S.I.W.S. N. R. SWAMY COLLEGE OF COMMERCE & ECONOMICS

AND

SMT. THIRUMALAI COLLEGE OF SCIENCE

This MoU is entered on 20th June 2020 by and between S.I.W.S. N. R. SWAMY COLLEGE OF COMMERCE & ECONOMICS AND SMT. THIRUMALAI COLLEGE OF SCIENCE, Plot No. 337, Sewri Wadala Estate, Major R. Parmeshwaran Marg, Wadala, Mumbai 400031 (hereinafter called S.I.W.S. College), affiliated to The University of Mumbai

And

Dr. Chandralekha Venkateshan SIWS Medical Center, (hereinafter known as Health Care) Wadala, Mumbai 400 031

This document will serve as the operating agreement between SIWS College and Dr. Chandralekha Venkateshan of SIWS Medical Centre for the purpose of delivering health care services to the students and staff attending SIWS College.

This is an agreement between SIWS College and SIWS Medical Center known as Health Care

WHEREAS, SIWS College desires to provide primary health care services to its staff and students and Health Care is willing to provide the same.



Primary care includes health promotion, disease prevention, health maintenance, patient education, diagnosis and medical advice for treatment of illnesses.

Now, therefore, SIWS College and the Health care, in consideration of the mutual promises and undertakings herein contained, agree as follows:

I. Purpose and Scope

- a) The sole aim of the MoU is to promote and ensure physical and mental health care, as well as other support services to students helping them to achieve optimal health status and maximizing their academic performance.
- b) The aim is that Health care will take an active role in providing primary health care services to all both teaching and non-teaching staff who are currently employed and all students who are currently studying in SIWS College to better understand and manage their health.
- c) Healthcare will do medical advice for two days in a week for two hours at the Health Centre of SIWS College to link them up with health resources in the local community.
- d) Healthcare will provided referral services to the participants of the program.
- e) They will also be providing health education workshops to staff and student on topics as per their requirements and health status.
- f) They will not actually be facilitating medical nursing procedures.
- g) One teaching staff will be designated to take the responsibility of enrolling the staff and students at the time of examination by the Health care.
- h) The participants with health issues will be asked to come again for follow up as per requirements by Health care to ensure preventive methods and promote good health.

II. Terms and Conditions:

- a. Health Care will continue health service provision to teachers and students, the financial arrangements will be made as per the mutually agreed terms.
- b. This MoU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time.

- c. Either party shall have the right to terminate this MoU upon 30 days prior written notice to the other party.
- d. On mutual consent of both the parties, review meetings will be conducted once in three months with co-ordinators, Vice-Principals and Principal.
- e. Health Care has to provide a report to the College once in three months about the activities conducted.
- f. The delivery of health services by Health Care should be within the established policies and procedures of SIWS College and in accordance with their requirements.

III. Duration of MoU:

This MoU unless extended by mutual written consent of the parties, shall expire in two **years** after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, this MoU shall be extended for another two years by mutual consent.

- IV. Consent form: Primary health care services from **Health Care** will be permitted only with signed parental consent. Participants will have to sign a consent form before undergoing the medical service.
- V. Space and Utilities: SIWS College will provide space and utilities to Health Care to operate that includes trash removal, general cleaning etc.
- VI. **Confidentiality**: Health Care will abide by policies and procedures with respect to confidentiality of the students' educational and other records.
- VII. Force Majeure. In the event and to the extent either Party is unable to perform its obligations under this Agreement because of any act of nature, civil disturbance, fire, flood, riot, war, terrorist attack, picketing, strike, lockout, work stoppage, loss of transportation facilities, governmental action or any condition or cause beyond such Party's control, such Party shall be excused from performance of the Contract.



VIII. SIWS College will intermittently review practices of the Health Care to monitor outcomes and fulfillment of the compliances with parental consent.

All activities undertaken through this memorandum are for the purpose of maintaining good health of students attending the College and supporting the college's educational mission.

Health Care will work collaboratively to meet goals, objectives and requirements of SIWS College.
