# ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020 – 21

(Term from June 2020 to December 2021 - Extended due to Pandemic)

The academic year 2020-2021 has been an unprecedented year in the history of S.I.W.S. due to Covid-19 pandemic. The challenges, restrictions and ongoing uncertainties resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic had to be addressed with substantial re-alignment of academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities in an ever-evolving environment. There has been a digital transformation in the conduct of all academic activities in this year. The administration, teachers, students, office staff and website service provider worked hand in hand so that the education process shall continue without cessation even during these adverse times.

# I. A) CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

- 1) Admissions: Due to the pandemic situation, this year the admission process was designed completely online. The College website was extensively used to guide students about steps in admission process. An admission Committee was formed and a helpdesk email was created on website to address technical doubts raised by students.
- 2) Interview of Assistant Professors for Self-financing courses: The SIW Society had advertised for the post of Assistant Professors for various programs under Self-financing courses in the Indian Express and Loksatta dated 29-7-2020. The applications were scrutinized based on qualification, experience and merit. A Selection Committee was formed and the interviews for Assistant Professors for the Commerce and Science Section of the self-financing courses were conducted on 21st and 27th August, 2020 respectively.

3) Online lectures: As per the University of Mumbai circular no. UG/01 of 2020-21 dated 2nd August, 2020 and REG/ICC/2020-21/08 dated 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2020, the online lectures for **Second and Third year** for all the streams started from 7<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 and lectures for all streams of the **First year** began from 16<sup>th</sup> **September, 2020.** The teachers used the lockdown period not only for organizing and attending webinars but also for development of e-content so that lecture delivery online becomes effective. The 'Google classroom/Google meet' platform was made available for the online lectures. The students' response for online teaching has been very encouraging during the pandemic.

# 4) Examinations:

**Final Year University Examinations**: As per the guidelines issued by University of Mumbai in Circular No. Exam/DBOEE/ICC/2020-21-04 dated 13th September, 2020, the UG as well as PG final year examinations had to be planned to be conducted online. Our College being a **Lead college in the Cluster 5**, played instrumental role in stream lining the entire online examination process by taking regular meetings with representatives of other colleges in cluster, deciding examination pattern, finalization of time table and timely delivery of reports to the University.

For the first time in the history of the University of Mumbai exams are being conducted **online**. The time table for all examinations were displayed on College website well in advance and circulated in students' whats app groups. Google Meet was set up for the purpose of proctoring. The UG/PG examinations were successfully conducted during the months of September, October and December.

All the examinations were conducted online using Google classroom - Google Meet - Google Forms format. It is important to note that Principal Dr. Usha Iyer took initiatives as a Lead College to urge all the colleges under cluster 5 for the smooth conduct of exams and speedy declaration of results.

The regular examinations of even semesters of F.Y. and S.Y. for all courses were scheduled in the month of April, 2021. Using Google Classroom - Google Meet platform, the internal examinations were completed. For external examinations of

MCQ type questions, the examination software by Biyani technology was used. Vice Principals, Examination Committee and officials from Biyani Technology trained teachers to use the software, set question papers, schedule examinations, etc. All the UG examinations of FY and SY were conducted smoothly.

# I. B) NAAC RELATED ACTIVITIES:

- 1) NAAC Online meetings with staff members: The Principal and IQAC Coordinator organized online meeting with the committee members of Criteria I and II on 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2020. The allocation of work regarding collection of information and numerical data for the seven NAAC criteria was executed. Seven committees were apprised of the data collection for all the seven criteria. The teachers were explained about the format of the information to be collected from the staff members and the college office.
- 2) NAAC Committee meeting for website upgradation: College website is an indispensable component in NAAC review process. The Principal, IQAC Coordinator and NAAC committee members had a meeting with college website service provider Mr. Krishna Ramanujam of Datavista solutions on 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2020. Mr. Krishna was told about the upgradation of website as per NAAC requirements.
- 3) NAAC Committee meeting for taking a review on current and upcoming courses of College: The Principal, Vice Principal and NAAC committee members had a meeting with the Hon. Joint Secretary of S.I.W.S. Mr. M.N. Ramamurthy on 18<sup>th</sup> January 2021. In the meeting the current status of various courses run by college, the scope for future expansion of existing courses and starting of new courses were discussed.
- **4)** As per the notice taken out by Principal dated **25**<sup>th</sup> **January**, **2021**, all the teachers were asked to come to college for the two days in a week for preparations with regard to NAAC documentation.

- 5) The Principal called a meeting of the Science faculty on 27<sup>th</sup> January 2021, and the Commerce faculty on 28<sup>th</sup> January 2021, to discuss on the documentation of criteria 1 & 2 of the NAAC. The teachers have been geared for speedy documentation of the NAAC work.
- 6) Website Committee meeting on 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2021: Website Committee meeting to upgrade website as per NAAC requirements was held on 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2021. Principal, Vice Principals and eight members of the committee were present for the meeting. Principal and IQAC Coordinator briefed the teachers about the various information to be collected from the college departments and to be sent to Mr. Krishna for uploading on the website.
- 7) NAAC Committee meeting to discuss the NAAC SSR Criteria 3 and 4 on 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2021: A NAAC Committee meeting to discuss the information to be collected for SSR Criteria 3 and 4 was conducted on 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2021. Principal, Vice Principals and teaching staff of the NAAC & IQAC Committee were present for the meeting. Principal and IQAC Coordinator explained the committee members the qualitative and quantitative information to be collected and compiled for the criteria 3 & 4.
- 8) NAAC Committee meeting to discuss the NAAC SSR Criteria 5 on 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2021: A NAAC Committee meeting to discuss the information to be collected for SSR Criteria 5 was conducted on 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2021. Principal, Vice Principals and five staff members were present for the meeting. Principal and IQAC Coordinator explained the committee members the qualitative and quantitative information to be collected and compiled for the said criteria.
- 9) Website Committee Meeting (2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2021): A website committee meeting was held on 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2021. Principal, Vice Principals, eight teaching staff members from different sections and website administrator Mr. Krishna were present for the meeting. A review of information uploaded as per the instructions from previous meetings was done. The information that is pending to be uploaded from NAAC point of view was discussed. The website administrator was told to be

more proactive, execute innovative ideas and improve the design and structure of the website display.

10) Meeting of Self-financing courses teachers with Principal (2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2021): A meeting of teachers of self-financing courses with the Principal was held on 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2021. Ten staff members including Principal and Vice Principals were present for the meeting. Principal briefed the teachers about the seven NAAC criteria and the information that has to be collected for the same. The teachers put forth the academic difficulties they are facing in the pandemic situation in online teaching to which satisfactory solutions were given by the Principal.

# 11) NEP Webinar organized by Management for Faculty:

The South Indian Welfare Society organized an 'Online Panel Discussion on NEP 2020 - Relevance to Teachers' on 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2021. The objective of the panel discussion was to enable teachers to understand the dimensions about National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and what teachers need to do proactively. Dr. V. Rangaraj, Chairman, Advisory Board, S.I.W.S was instrumental in organizing the event. Mr. R. Radhakrishnan Chairman, S.I.W.S, Mr. M. Ananthasubramanian, Honorary General Secretary, Mr. M.N. Ramamurthy, Honorary Joint Secretary, and Mr. Muralidharan Srinivasan, Trustee, were present for the program.

Dr. A D Sawant - Former Vice Chancellor, Rajasthan University & Former Pro-VC, University of Mumbai, Dr Rajan Saxena - Former Vice Chancellor, NMIMS, Dr. Dinesh D Harsolekar - Director, IES Management College and Research Centre, Dr. Shobana Vasudevan - Principal, Podar College were the panellists for the program. Dr. Mohan B Rao - Professor & Associate Dean- IES Management College and Research Centre acted as a moderator. The panellists discussed NEP 2020 in three rounds as Helicopter view about the NEP-2020, Role of teachers in NEP-2020 and Challenges in implementing NEP-2020 followed by Question and Answer session. 97 teachers participated in the program.

SIWS Chairman Mr. R. Radhakrishnan gave his concluding remarks thanking the panelists for the great ideas in the implementation of NEP. He complimented Dr. V. Rangaraj for taking the lead to organize such an innovative program. He stated

that the management always looks forward to empower teachers to bring out the best in them. Dr. V. Rangaraj proposed the vote of thanks and expressed his gratitude to the panellists for accepting the invitation and being a part of this very fruitful discussion.

# I. C) DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES - COMMERCE

The departments, with the focus to enhance academic quality, organized a series of student centric activities.

# 1) Department of Business Economics:

a) Webinar titled 'Introduction to the Stock Market' by the Department of Business Economics on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2021.: Internal Quality Assurance Cell (I.Q.A.C.) & Department of Business Economics organized a webinar on 'Introduction to the Stock Market' on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2021. Principal Dr Usha Iyer welcomed resource person Mr. Veeraraghavan Viswanathan Manager, Motilal Oswal Finance Services Ltd and the participants. Mr. Veeraraghavan Viswanathan gave an insightful presentation about the working of the stock market. He explained about the importance of portfolio management, about equities and how companies raised interest free capital from the stock market. 159 students benefitted from the program.

# b) Online Short Term Certificate Course on 'Entrepreneurial Development

Program': The Departments of Business Economics, Banking and Insurance and Internal Quality Assurance Cell, in collaboration with Artiglee Solutions LLP, Ahmedabad 380015, successfully conducted the **15 day Online Short Term Certificate Course** on **'Entrepreneurial Development Program'** from **20 September to 6 October 2021.** The sessions were conducted by a team of young professionals with expertise in the startup domain and experienced academicians.

c) International Workshop on 'Research Methodology in Social Sciences:

The Departments of Business Economics and Commerce (Aided & Self-Finance Courses) jointly with I.Q.A.C. of our college in collaboration with International

Institute for Population Sciences (I.I.P.S.) organized an International workshop on Research Methodology in Social Sciences from 5 - 9 October, 2021. The participants who registered for the program included post graduate students, research scholars and faculty from different parts of the country. Dr. Ravi Verma, Director of International Centre for Research on Women (ICRW) Asia Chapter, New Delhi was the Chief Guest and Dr K.S James, Director, IIPS was the Guest of Honour for the inaugural function. Dr. Priya Emmart, Deputy Director, Track 20, Avenir Health, Glastonbury, CT, USA was the Chief Guest for valedictory function. 116 participants attended the workshop. The participants shared their feedback and mentioned that they gained immensely from the rich experience of the resource persons who were from all over India and abroad. The program received a lot of appreciation from the academic circles.

d) Webinar on 'A Date with Yourself': The Department of Business Economics, Alumnii Association and I.Q.A.C. organized a webinar on 'A Date with Yourself' on 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2021. Mr. Viren Sanghavi, an alumnus of 1995-1996 batch was the eminent resource person. The webinar was open for the students across all the streams.

# 2) Department of Accountancy:

- a) Webinar on Investment Opportunities for Beginners on 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2021: Investing in correct path to get desired returns is a crucial challenge in the current trend of pandemic driven inflation, post COVID times. IQAC and Department of Accountancy organized a webinar on the topic Investment Opportunities for Beginners on 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2021. Mr. Bhargav Mevawala, Manager (Sales), Mumbai Region, DSP Mutual funds was the resource person. He stressed in his speech the limitations in investing in traditional avenues of investment and how mutual funds are the most beneficial ways of creating wealth in the long term. The webinar was very successful with 723 participants.
- b) Online certificate course in 'Basics of e-filing under Corporate Laws': I.Q.A.C., Department of Accountancy and B.Com (Accountancy & Finance) jointly organised an Online Certificate Course in 'Basics of E-Filing under

Corporate Laws' from 8 - 27 September, 2021. 63 students enrolled for the course. The objective of the course was to provide theoretical and practical knowledge of Company Law and compliances to be made by Companies and Limited Liability Partnerships.

- c) Online Certificate Course in 'Guidance for NET/SET Examination': I.Q.A.C., and Department of M.Com jointly organised an Online Certificate Course in 'Guidance for NET/SET Examination' for all Commerce students between 4 14 October, 2021. 24 students enrolled for the course. The course faculty comprised of academicians and professionals from the fields of Commerce, Accounting, Economics and Taxation. The course provided theoretical and practical knowledge in the subjects of Commerce.
- d) Webinar on 'Preparation for Competitive Exams': I.Q.A.C. and Department of Master of Commerce jointly organized an exclusive Webinar on 'Preparation for Competitive Exam' for students to help them in choosing a career and start identifying their areas of interest on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2021 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. Dr. Mahesh Balkrishna Bhagwat, Vice principal Mithibai college was the resource person. It had an enthusiastic response with 281 participants all over including students from B.Com., B.M.S., B.B.I., B.A.F & M.Com from various colleges. The webinar created an awareness about curriculum and paper pattern of various competitive exams viz. MPSC, UPSC, NABARD, LIC and Bank exams.
- e) Session on How to trade in Stock Market: The I.Q.A.C. and Department of M.Com., jointly organized an exclusive session on 'How to Trade in Stock Market', on 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 from 4 p.m. to 5 p.m. for students to understand nitty-gritty of the stock market. The Resource person was Mr. Abhishek Samal, Subject Expert & Corporate Trainer SEBI. The program organized during World Investor week had an enthusiastic response with 107 participants including teachers and students from B.Com., B.M.S., B.B.I., B.A.F & M.Com.

# 3) Department of Commerce:

- a) Department of Commerce in collaboration with Technoserve N.G.O. organized Training and Counselling Session on 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 and 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2021. Thirty six students participated in the training program. The training covered personal effectiveness, communication readiness, presentation skills, career readiness and work readiness. Individual counselling was also done during the program to understand the strength of each student that helped them to choose their career path.
- b) Career Guidance Webinar: I.Q.A.C. and the Department of Commerce in collaboration with Arena Animation, Dadar organized a Webinar on 'Career Guidance' on 26-27 November, 2021 from 11 a.m. to 12 noon presided by faculty from Arena Animation, Mr. Shahbaaz and Mr. Mahesh. They assisted students by informing about educational and occupational choices in their career, redefining their career path in the creative arts industry. They highlighted some areas in animation and introduced some basic features of creating animated video. The participants became familiar with the upcoming area of Animation and its applications. The program had a good response of 139 participants and they seemed quite enthusiastic related to animation.
- c) Short Term Course on Corporate Social Responsibility Demystified:

  Departments of Commerce, Business Economics, B.M.S., B.B.I., B.A.F.,
  B.A.M.M.C. & Internal Quality Assurance Cell organized a Short Term Certificate
  Course on Corporate Social Responsibility Demystified from 2 13 December,
  2021. The 30 Hours program aimed at sensitizing students about the contemporary
  CSR issues in the present scenario. Speakers threw light on the importance & scope of CSR in the 21<sup>st</sup> century and presented a brief overview of the various CSR strategies implemented by Corporates today. 63 participants benefitted from the course.

# 4) Department of Environmental Studies:

a) Under the leadership of Principal and Vice Principals, a webinar regarding admission procedure of all first year courses in S.I.W.S. College was organized on

- 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2020. The Department of Environmental Studies took the lead to explain to the students the procedure to register to the University of Mumbai admission portal and complete the pre-registration process followed by admission process on college website. Students were alerted about common mistakes done by them. A gist of academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities available in the college was also shown to the students. 138 students participated in the webinar. The queries raised by students were answered by authorities during the question and answer session.
- I.Q.A.C. and Department of Environmental Studies in collaboration with Aniruddha's Academy of Disaster Management (AADM), Mumbai organized Online Certificate Course on Introduction to Disaster Management from 25th August, 2021 to 3rd September, 2021. The duration of the program was 30 hours. The speciality of the program was a 14 hours online training session conducted by the experts of AADM in addition to the guest lectures by experienced academicians and experts in the field. The course was designed with the objectives to plan for all the stages of disaster management towards the disasters happening around us, assess the key issues related to disaster risk reduction, response and recovery and enhance participant's knowledge and skills to equip them on emergency planning and response. 32 participants were trained in the course.
- Mr. Mahesh Narvekar, Chief Officer, Disaster Management Cell, Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (M.C.G.M.) graced the valedictory function. Evaluation and Certification were based on the scores obtained by candidates in the MCQ test conducted daily. The overall Impact for all the days as rated by majority of the participants for the sessions was Excellent. The participants requested the college to conduct the training session physically in the college when the pandemic situation is relaxed.
- d) Certificate Course on Greener Approaches to Environmental Problems organized by the Departments of Physics, Chemistry, Microbiology, Environmental Studies & I.Q.A.C.: This course was designed to make students aware of the emerging environmental challenges and to train them to promote the

idea of conservation and sustainability at individual level. The course was inaugurated by Mr. Stalin Dayanand, Director, Vanashakti N.G.O., Mumbai. The 30 hours course comprised of lectures delivered by stalwarts from eminent institutes in the field of environmental science such as NEERI Nagpur, ICT Mumbai, Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Biotechnology, Nagpur, Sanctuary Nature Foundation, Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology, Environmental Consultants, N.G.O. Personnels and academicians. The course was attended by 309 students of our college across all the streams and 47 students of Balkumari College, Nepal. This online course concluded on 8th December, 2021. The Chief Guest for the Valedictory Function was Mr. Jagadishwar Khanal, Principal, Balkumari College. He thanked Principal Usha Iyer and the entire organizing team for extending the opportunity of participation to the students of Balkumari College, Nepal and inviting him as Chief Guest. He also wished to conduct more such programs in collaboration with SIWS College.

# 5) Department of Business Law:

a) I.Q.A.C and Department of Business Law conducted two days webinar on 'Impact of Force Majeure Clause during COVID-19 Pandemic' and 'Intellectual Property Rights' on 11th & 12th June, 2020.

On Day 1, Advocate Yatin Pandit, delivered a talk on 'Impact of Force Majeure Clause during COVID-19 Pandemic' enlightening the participants with crisp and lucid contents, receiving great applauses from the faculty and students. Though the subject was technical, the speaker made the topic very simple and made the participants understand the concept of Force Majeure and its relevance and significance in today's scenario which deals with relief from contractual obligation and liabilities of the parties due to natural calamities and pandemics.

Advocate Suyash V. Pradhan, delivered a talk on **Intellectual Properties Rights** on Day 2 covering concepts of Patent, Patentable Inventions, and Patent Filing with examples and case laws. He explained the Copy Rights, the duration of rights, plagiarism, importance and significant of registration of Copyright and its process.

The Two Days Webinar was well received and attended by over **256** participants consisting of faculty, students and professionals from various states in India and abroad. All the participants were given a certificate for active participation.

b) Two Days Faculty Development Program on 'Legal Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)': I.Q.A.C. and the Department of Business Law jointly organized Two Days Faculty Development Program on 'Legal Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)' on 22 - 23 October, 2021. ACS Rushabh Desai was the eminent resource person for the program. The program was attended by 72 enthusiastic teacher participants throughout the country. The resource person shared his knowledge in lucid manner with apt examples of day to day life.

# 6) Department of Business Communication:

- a) Communication in the Contemporary Context Certificate Course organized by the I.Q.A.C. & The Department of Business Communication: The IQAC and the Department of Business Communication organized a certificate course in Business Communication 'Communication in the Contemporary Context' between 27 July, 2021- 14 August, 2021. Seventeen distinguished academicians tackled various aspects of Business Communication, broadly bearing in mind, the objectives of the course. 58 students attended the course and were found eligible to receive the certificate. Participants were tested on a regular basis and the evaluation was made at the conclusion of the course. The lecture series met the stated objectives as validated by the overall feedback of the registered participants.
- Personal Success': The Public Speaking and Debating Society of H.R. College in collaboration with the Department of Business Communication of S.I.W.S. College conducted a Webinar on Honing Life Skills from the 21- 23 September 2020 using the Digital Video Conferencing platform Zoom. Mr. Ketan Bhagat, author and screen play writer engaged the day 1 session. He spoke on the topic 'Lessons that are not taught in school or college'. Mrs. Santhini Govindan, freelance editor and author was the speaker for day 2 to speak on 'The Right Way to Write Writing An important life skill'. The concluding day lecture was engaged by Dr.

**Suchitra Sarkar**, Associate Professor, D.T.S.S. College, Mumbai. The workshop was attended by 136 participants.

c) Webinar titled Values: A Compass for Navigating Uncertain Times: A webinar titled Values: A Compass for Navigating Uncertain Times was organised by Universal Human Values Cell, University of Mumbai in collaboration with IQAC and Department of Business Communication, on Saturday, 27<sup>th</sup> November,2021. The webinar comprised of five speakers, Dr Smita Shukla, Incharge director of Alkesh Dinesh Mody Institute for Financial and Management Studies, Prof Vasanthi Kadhiravan, Professor, Dept. of Physical Education, Prof Linda Dhakul, Assistant Professor, St. Xavier's College, Mumbai, Dr. Priya Vaidya, Associate Professor, Dept. of Philosophy, the University of Mumbai and Dr. Wilbur Gonsalves, Assistant Professor, Dept.of Applied Psychology, the University of Mumbai. 51 students attended the webinar.

# 7) Department of Mathematics:

- a) The department of Mathematics organized a national webinar on 'COVID 19: Challenges in Mathematical Modelling' on 8th June, 2020. Professor Malay Banerjee from Indian Institute of Technology, Kanpur, a leading mathematical biologist in India, was the guest speaker for the webinar. Dr Peeyush Chandra, Ex-Head of the Department of Mathematics and Statistics, Indian Institute of Technology, Kanpur also graced the occasion with his presence. The webinar was focussed on the mathematical modelling of epidemiology with special emphasis on COVID 19. Dr Banerjee in his talk analysed the COVID data of various countries to build up the base for Kermack Mckendricks's SIR model for epidemics. He discussed SEIJR and SEIQR models for the spread of COVID 19 which are basically ODE models besides touching upon various alternative approaches for the modelling of COVID 19. There were 330 participants for the webinar.
- b) Career Guidance Talk and Interactive Session: The Department of Mathematics of our College organized an Intercollegiate Online Career Guidance Talk and Interactive Session for all Science Students on 'Preparing for Premiere Institutes in India after Graduation' on September 18, 2021. Mr. Nitin Tomar,

Research Scholar, IIT Mumbai was the speaker for the same. The session was focused on important factors in facing Entrance Exams like IIT JEE etc. after completing Graduation in Science. **68** participants including students of science from various colleges and various subjects under science attended the webinar.

- c) Certificate Course on Computational Techniques in Vedic Mathematics: The Department of Mathematics and I.Q.A.C. organized a 30 hour certificate course titled 'Computational Techniques in Vedic Mathematics' from 16-30 October, 2021. The course involved lectures by experts in the field and daily problem solving sessions. Graded e-certificates were awarded to all the 62 registered and qualified participants.

# **COMMUNITY SERVICE:**

  - to help the flood victims of Chiplun Mahad (Konkan) by donation of kits with daily essentials. The NSS volunteers made an appeal to the students and staff members to donate for the social cause.
