Student Satisfaction Survey is an important instrument of understanding the thinking process of the students. All the efforts of teachers and the institution to make learning a meaningful process is judged by its impact on the students and the contribution to their mental development.

The students' satisfaction level is decided by the kinds of experiences they undergo, the extent of the 'comfort' feeling as well as intellectual stimulation the learning situations provide. Their feedback significantly showcases the actual quality of teaching-learning process.

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is a tool to identify the strengths of teaching and enables academic enrichment. Student satisfaction, thus, is a direct indicator of the effectiveness of teaching learning in the institution.

The Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) was carried out in an online mode for the academic year 2020-2021. Thirty four questions designed by I.Q.A.C. were incorporated in the questionnaire. The online mode ensured that there is no human interference in collection and analysis of data. Feedback report was prepared manually. The report was presented to I.Q.A.C. Committee Members in the I.Q.A.C. meeting, approved and communicated to authorities for further action.

31. Welfare schemes for students like scholarships, fellowships, etc. are available.



17% students provided excellent, very good or good response for overall teaching – learning experience. Some of the suggestions given by the students for improvement are:


- 1. Make teaching a two way interaction

- 8. Digital learning, good explanation, giving attention to every student




























34. Give three observations / suggestions to improve the institution.
