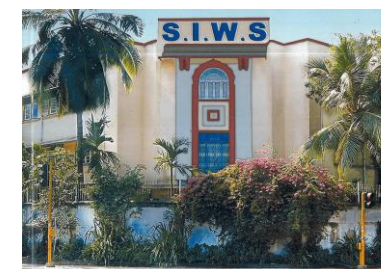

Researchers, academicians, and professionals from different fields are invited to contribute and make Paper/Poster presentation on the seminar themes and are requested to upload their Full Paper in word format on the link provided. In case of Poster Presentation, upload pdf file on the link provided.

Abstract: The abstract must state the Objectives, Research Methodology, Analysis & Implications of Research.

Full Paper:

The paper should not be plagiarized, and should be free from grammatical, spelling, or any other errors. Full paper within 2500 words, typed in MS Word should be uploaded on the link provided.

The full paper should include the following:

- Abstract (max 250 words)
- 4-5 key words
- Introduction
- Literature Review
- Methodology
- Data Analysis (If any)
- Discussion and Implications
- Conclusion
- References

The paper should clearly mention the Title, Name, and Association of the author(s), Sub theme of the Seminar for which it is being submitted, and contact details of the Corresponding author on its cover page.

The manuscript should be formatted as follows:
