# ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022 - 2023

S.I.W.S. College constantly strives for academic excellence. The journey which started in 1980 has exhibited an upward trend till date in the fields of academic, co-curricular, extra-curricular and extension activities. In the age of globalization, where information is universally and easily available, the College has striven to provide the tools necessary for our students to face the challenges of the competent world. The College takes untiring efforts to provide educational opportunities to socially and economically weak students and offer quality education to them, this involves problem solving and imparting leadership skills as was perceived by our founders and enshrined in our mission. The year 2022-2023 was marked with activities and events successfully conducted by students, guided by the teachers. This is attributed to the dedication and team spirit of energetic students, hardworking staff members, dedicated administration and vibrant management.

#### A) NAAC Related Activities:

I.Q.A.C. from its inception has played a pivotal role in bolstering the institutional quality standard. The prime agenda of I.Q.A.C. for this academic year was to go for third cycle of N.A.A.C. accreditation. The Self Study Report submission process and Data Validation and Verification was accomplished in online mode on N.A.A.C. portal. This was followed by preparations of departments and associations for their presentations to N.A.A.C. peer team visit on 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> October, 2022.

The team members scrutinised all the documents of past five years, interacted with all the stakeholders, attended presentations by departments, visited the campus to check the facilities and augmentation of infrastructure and found to be satisfied by seeing the progress of the institution as was perceived in the exit meeting.

The N.A.A.C. Bangalore in their meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2022 declared grades. The S.I.W.S. College was awarded 'A' Grade with CGPA 3.15 score out of 4. The team members have

recommended suggestions for improvement of academics and infrastructure. This will be done in due course.

# **B)** Academic Activities:

- 1) **Department of Accountancy and B.A.F.** conducted two Certificate Courses on the topics:
  - ➤ Basic of E-Filing under Income Tax Laws
  - Securities Market and Investors Awareness Program

Students enthusiastically participated in these courses.

- 2) **Department of Commerce** organized Soft Skill Development Program in association with Technoserve A U.S. based Multi-National N.G.O.
- 3) **Department of Business Economics** organised a workshop on 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 on the theme 'Save Energy Today to Secure Your Tomorrow'. The resource person Ms. Rashmi Joshi, an environment consultant conducted the workshop. Fifty-eight students attended the workshop.

An industrial visit to Rajasthan was organised by the Departments of Business Economics, Commerce, Accountancy and Business Law between 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2022. Forty-eight students participated in the visit. Students visited Kagzi industry. The manager of the industry took lots of effort to make our students understand the making of hand-made paper. Yellow Stone Cutting and Carving industry was also visited.

#### 4) Department of Business Communication

The Department of Business Communication and the Department of English, H.R. College in collaboration, organised a two-days online workshop for teachers titled 'Research Requisites-A Workshop for Teachers' on 5 and 6 December, 2022. Around hundred teacher participants attended the online workshop on both the days. The objective of the workshop was to create awareness about the process of publication and introduce the participants to various citation styles.

The English Literary Association and D.L.L.E. team organised an 'Essay Writing Competition' on the value of the month- 'Truth' on 24<sup>th</sup> December, 2022. 90 students

participated in the competition. The objective of the Essay Writing Competition was to hone writing skills of students.

5) Department of Environmental Studies and Nature Club/Hiking club organised a webinar on 'What lies beneath Understanding Ground water and its role in our water security' on 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2022. Mr. Dhaval Joshi, School of Geosciences, University of Edinburgh, U.K. was the resource person for the same. 241 students across faculty, actively participated in the program.

The Department of Business Economics and Department of Environmental Studies organized Poster Making Competition on **UN Sustainable Development Goals**. Students were explained to select any one of the 17 goals for poster. Eleven students took part in the competition.

The Department in association with I.Q.A.C. organized a **webinar** on 'Energy Conservation' on 17<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 to celebrate our country hosting the **18<sup>th</sup> G20 Summit** based on the central concept of 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam' (One Earth, One Family, One Future). Dr. Hemant Pednekar, Director iFactor and Director & Advisor, Konkan Geographers' Association was the resource person. The webinar helped students to understand the ways with which energy can be conserved in daily routine.

- 6) Department of Mathematics organized Online Certificate Course On 'Vedic Mathematics for Beginners' from 31st October to 15th November, 2022. Sixty-eight students attended the course.
- 7) **Department of Physics** organised a guidance lecture about '**JAM Examination in Physics**' on 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. Resource person was our Alumni Mr. Rohit Sharma who got admission for M.Sc. Ph.D. program in Physics at IIT Bhubaneswar. Twenty-three students from S.Y.B.Sc. & T.Y.B.Sc. participated in the session.
- ➤ Department also organized an **Essay writing competition** on '**Know Our Scientists**' on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2022 to create awareness about these scientists and their achievements among undergraduate science students. Twenty-two students participated in the activity.
- ➤ Bridge Course Basic Mathematical Tools Applied in Physics: Bridge course was designed to familiarise students with various mathematical tools involved in the F.Y.B.Sc. Physics courses. The course was conducted between 25<sup>th</sup> August and 10<sup>th</sup> September, 2022. The entire course was of fifteen hours duration. It included concepts from Calculus, Algebra,

- Graph plotting and use of scientific calculator in an effective manner. Sixty-five students attended the course.
- ➤ Certificate Course -Programming with Python was organised by the Department of Physics & I.Q.A.C. from 5<sup>th</sup> August to 10<sup>th</sup> September, 2022. Forty hours duration course was attended by twenty students of S.Y. and T.Y.B.Sc. Physics and T.Y.B.Sc. I.T.
- ➤ The Department organised a bridge course titled 'Microprocessor 8085: Architecture and Basic Programming' for T.Y.B.Sc. students. It was conducted from 21<sup>st</sup> November to 9<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 for a total of twenty-two hours. Twelve T.Y.B.Sc. Physics students participated.
- ➤ Department of Physics and I.Q.A.C. organized intra-collegiate festival "PHYSICA 22-23" on 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2023. Students got an opportunity to relearn the applications and uses of components and instruments used in physics. Dr. Radha Srinivasan, Associate Professor, Department of Physics, the University of Mumbai was the chief guest.

# 8) Department of Chemistry-

- Expectations of Industries from Freshers' by Dr. Hemant Joglekar, Asian Paints. It was held on 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. The objective of this talk was to create awareness about research and to groom our students to face challenges after graduation. Seventy-two students attended the talk.
- ➤ A 15 hours bridge course was initiated by the department teachers for F.Y.B.Sc. students from 23<sup>rd</sup> December, 2022. This course catered to clear their basic concepts in Chemistry. Ninety-two students participated.

Prof. Shivram Garje, Dean (Science & Technology), the University of Mumbai was the Chief Guest.
