Report on 'Leadership Training Camp'

In observance of 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav of India' the Planning Forum in association with Forum of Free Enterprise & M.R. Pai Foundation organized a two-day Leadership Training Program for degree college students from 12-13 August 2022, with the following objectives:

- To promote leadership and management skills among students
- To enable self-awareness and self-empowerment

Mr. Rajiv Kumar Luv, is a trainer, motivational speaker, online coach, author, podcaster and YouTuber. He conducted sessions on setting and achieving goals through different activities. He discussed various aspects of habits- what is a habit, why habits are important how do we form habits and why it is important to unlearn our bad habits. He also discussed habit loops, keystone habits, etc. He motivated students to develop certain habits in the morning and night and draw up an action plan. He conducted different activities to make them understand the concept of leadership and the importance of team building with creative efforts.

On the second day, a session on sharpening vital skills, effective communication and understanding self & others were engaged by Mr. Shreepad Parkhe. He explained that it was important to sharpen our vital skills so that when opportunities come one can utilize them to achieve success in life. He explained the concept of 'OCEAN', which is used to enhance an individual's perception of others. When we start understanding ourselves, our approach and perception towards others and life changes. Participants took a keen interest and raised several queries related to leadership qualities and personality development for better understanding.

The camp attended by thirty-eight students ended with a valedictory session. Participants shared their experiences and provided their feedback for sessions.
