- A derivative is a financial instrument whose value is derived from the value of another asset, which is known as the underlying.
- When the price of the underlying changes, the value of the derivative also changes.
- A Derivative is not a product. It is a contract that derives its value from changes in the price of the underlying. **Example :** The value of a gold futures contract is derived from the value of the underlying asset i.e. Gold.

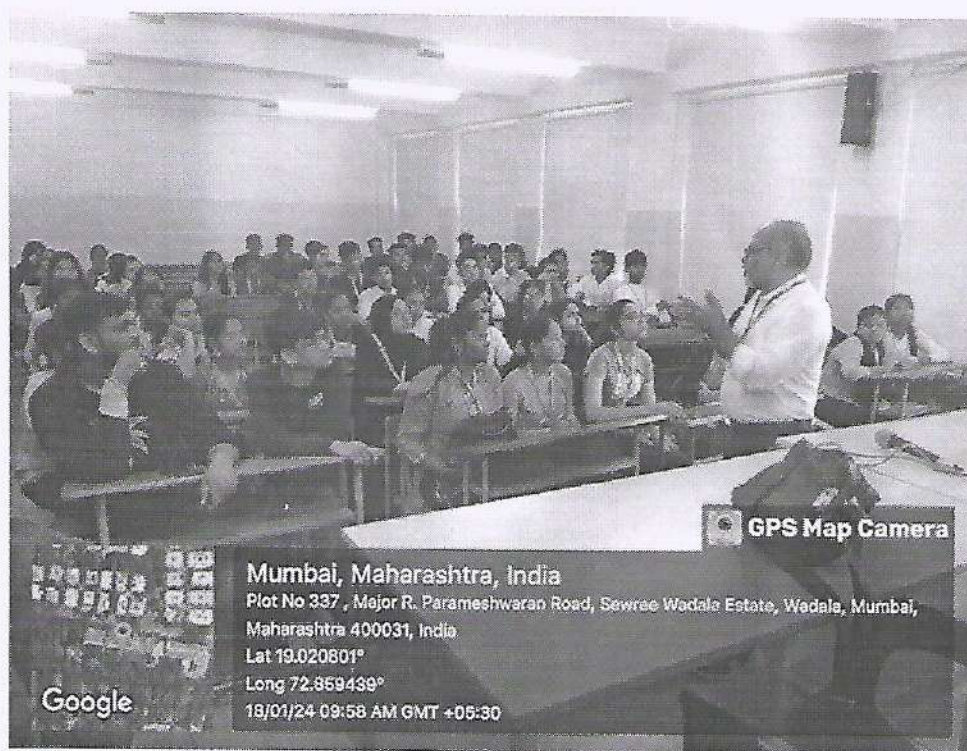

The session was concluded by votes of thank by Prof. Arul Kumar.

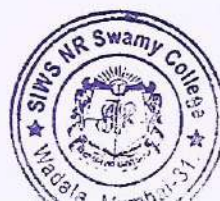
The entire students who attended the seminar were presented with participation certificates powered by the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE).


